

The Madison-Morgan Conservancy was recently part of a select team of Georgia conservation leaders advocating for conservation initiatives to Congressman Jody Hice in Washington, D.C.

"It was an honor to meet with the group from the Madison-Morgan Conservancy earlier this month. Through meeting with these important local leaders, I learned how important the tax incentive for land conservation has been and will continue to

be for years to come," said Hice. "Making this temporary tax incentive permanent is but one reason why I was proud to support the Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes Act of 2015. As businesses, non-profits such as the Madison-Morgan Conservancy, and other entities plan for the future, it is critical that they do so with the predictability and confidence that comes with a consistent and fair tax code."






