Are you interested in protecting Morgan County's environment, learning about its local history, or preserving its agricultural heritage?

Through education, civic engagement, community service, and social events, the Junior Conservancy offers high school students who reside in Morgan County the opportunity to become actively involved in protecting the County's special natural, agricultural, and historic resources. With guidance from Madison-Morgan Conservancy staff and trustees, Junior Conservancy Board Members will create and execute their own conservation-related programming throughout the school year.

The Madison-Morgan Conservancy is seeking applications from rising 9th-11th grade high school students in Morgan County to participate in the Junior Conservancy for the 2024-2025 school year. A good candidate will:

- Have an interest in the environment, history, and/or agriculture,
- Be in good academic standing,
- Have the drive to actively participate in Junior Conservancy meetings, events, and activities,
- Commit to seven meetings and three service events over the course of the school year, and a two night trip to the Len Foote Hike Inn. The aforementioned events and trip are mandatory for all members.
- Be curious about the place they live and interested in making it better through creative problem solving.

Past Junior Conservancy experiences have included:

- Kayaking at Hard Labor Creek State Park
- Participating in cemetery clean-ups
- Visiting the Athens landfill and recycling center
- Participating in Madison's Arbor Day proclamation celebration
- Touring the historic Nolan Crossroads
- Creating a new biking trail at the Boys and Girls Club
